SUBJECT:	General Managers Report

- 1.) Water Production/Loss: May, lost and unaccounted for water was 21%. Down 1% from April. Well production is at 61% of online well capacity.
- 2.) The Triannual ADEQ inspection was this month. We had just a few housekeeping issues that were resolved the same day.
- 3.) ADEQ informed us last week of rule changes with the synthetic chemicals known as PFAS that may impact water systems in the state. We are working together with ADEQ to assess our system. We will release more information as soon as we get it.
- 3.) In May, 29 leak reports were logged, and all were responded to the same day, except when the entire crew was tied up on large leaks.
- 4.) During May, 462 person-hours were dedicated to leak repairs.
- 5.) As of 6/21/22 at 10:05 am, we have no leaks open. However, crews consistently and systematically look for leak evidence, using our high tech audio testing equipment and ground penetration radar.
- 6.) Current drought staging is at stage 2. Try to save roughly 15% if possible. The community response has been very positive and productive so far; therefore, we have not yet had to implement stage 3.
