Customer Service Team Update

Our Customer Service team remains consistently busy with their core responsibilities, including notifying customers of potential leaks. In support of improved customer experience, the redesigned website now offers simpler navigation and enables more timely uploads of important documentation.

The team is also actively reorganizing and archiving documents stored in our storage unit to enhance accessibility and efficiency.

Beyond their daily duties, the team has been engaged in several community and office improvement initiatives. These include participating in the **Trunk or Treat** event, donating an unused handicap lift to a local resident, and painting the interior of the office to create a more welcoming environment.

Field Team Update


It's important to recognize that the duties our team performs — beyond their regular routines — are often physically demanding.
